**Severn Road Green (West of Severn Road) and Midland Road Green, Park Estate, Stonehouse:
Proposal to designate as Local Green Space in the draft Stonehouse Neighbourhood Plan**

The draft Stonehouse Neighbourhood Plan is seeking to introduce a Local Green Spaces Policy which proposes that five local green spaces be designated in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 77 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

We are writing to inform you that Severn Road Green (West of Severn Road) and Midland Road Green, Park Estate, Stonehouse are proposed to be designated as a local green space. This designation can be used in Local and Neighbourhood Plans to give protection against development for green areas of particular importance to local communities.

I attach:

- a map of the areas proposed for local green space designation
- a justification document summarising the reasons for the proposed designation
- a checklist identifying how the criteria for designation are met
