

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE)
TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION B4008 HIGH STREET
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has made an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and under all other enabling powers including The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 to restrict part of B4008 from outside the property known as 20 High Street to outside the property known as 24 High Street for a distance of approximately 30 metres.

The road falls within Stonehouse Town in the Stroud District in Gloucestershire.

The restriction is necessary due to measures that support the public in being able to social distance due to Covid-19 when frequenting Stonehouse High Street. A 20 minute parking bay and suspension of parking bays with planters will be implemented.

The road was originally restricted for 21 days by emergency Notice commencing 21st December 2020. However, the Coronavirus Guidance and Regulations which led to the restrictions remain in force and therefore it is necessary to extend the restriction by an Order, which can authorise the restriction of the road for up to eighteen months from the date of the original Notice. The road is expected to be restricted until 28th February 2021 For further information, please contact Gloucestershire Highways on **08000 514 514** or visit **www.gloucestershire.gov.uk**.
