

**GLoucestershire County Council (Coronavirus Response)**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION) B4008 HIGH STREET**  
**(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2021**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for B4008 from outside the property known as 20 High Street to outside the property known as 24 High Street for a distance of approximately 30 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be restricted and/or prohibited because it is necessary to bring in restrictions to allow compliance with Coronavirus guidance and regulations by the reducing/relocating the loading bay area.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers including The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The current restrictions on the Road are hereby suspended for the duration of this Temporary Order;
2. No person shall park nor wait or cause anyone to park nor wait along the Road unless it is in accordance with the restrictions described above through the duration of this Temporary Order;
3. The restrictions on the Road shall only operate when indicated by the traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
4. The Road falls in Stonehouse Town in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January Two Thousand and Twenty One and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months; from the date initially restricted by Notice;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order B4008 High Street (Stonehouse Town) Stroud District Order 2021"
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
