Stonehouse based voluntary, unsubscribed, not for profit community groups may apply to the Town Clerk for free use of facilities when they do not charge an entrance fee and the sole purpose of the event is to raise funds for charitable purposes. A damage deposit will however still apply 2. All events requiring the use of the town council's facilities must provide the town council with their Events/Public Liability Insurance, relevant licensing and safety documentation prior to the event taking place. 3. In the event of bad weather, the Town Council reserve the right to prevent use of any of its fields and pitches at the last minute if it is considered that the scheduled event may cause irreparable damage 4. Small Businesses wishing to run small outdoor classes ie exercise classes, on one of the council's playing fields may be allowed to do so providing they do not occupy an area in excess of 100 square metres of space and do not occupy an area allocated to an organised sport or event – there will be a requirement for the business owner to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. provide copies of their Public Liability Insurance and an appropriate Health and Safety Risk Assessment – to include Covid measures and, b. book a space with the council in advance c. may incur a charge if holding a regular event
