

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Council held on Monday 12th June 2023, 7pm at the Town Hall

Attendees were reminded that the <u>Proceedings</u> of the meeting could be filmed photographed or recorded.

In the absence of the Chair and Deputy Chair a motion was raised to appoint a Chair for the meeting. Councillor Gibbs was proposed and approved by the Full Council.

The meeting started promptly at 7pm.

Approximately 30 members of the public attended the meeting to voice concerns over the ongoing works in Verney Fields:

- The barbed wire along the narrow footpaths has not been removed.
- New residents have moved to the area, specifically for the open spaces to walk.
- MST 30 is not accessible to people with disabilities.
- Access to the bench under the Oak is very important to residents.
- The concrete steps are dangerous and are blocked by a tree branch.
- Other concrete steps are on land that isn't owned by the landowners.
- Who is liable for any injuries that may occur from the barbed wire or the concrete steps.
- A huge number of residents which to keep the longstanding footpaths.
- There are 16 CCTV cameras and residents are concerned about data protection.

- 1. E/649 For council to resolve to contact the Public Rights of Way department of Glos County Council and accept their offer to act as an intermediary to negotiate a resolution to the Public Rights of way across Verney Fields on the understanding that:
 - a. at least three public rights of way paths are registered on the definitive map and maintained for the safe use by site users in perpetuity.
 - b. that should agreement not be reached with the site owners by the end of June 2023, the town council, in acknowledgement of the community's strength of feeling, submits the applications and evidence in support of the Definitive Map Modifications Orders (DMMOs)

Council **APPROVED** Point 1, paragraph 1. There were **NO** proposers to approve (a), so **NOT** approved. Council **APPROVED** point 1b.

At this point in the meeting, members of the public were again thanked and reminded they are welcome to stay for the remainder of the meeting if they so wished. They all left the meeting.
