GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A419 EBLEY BYPASS AND A419 BRISTOL ROAD) (PARISHES
OF STONEHOUSE AND KINGS STANLEY) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the above-named order the effect of which is:

- 1) To implement a 30mph speed limit by virtue of streetlighting on a short stretch of the A419 Bristol Road, including Horsetrough Roundabout, and the A419 Ebley Bypass, including the dedicated left hand slip lane; and**
- 2) To reduce the extent of the existing 40mph speed limit on the A419 Bristol Road and the A419 Ebley Bypass to align with the new extent of 30mph speed limit.**

The lengths of roads fall within the Parishes of Stonehouse and Kings Stanley within the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st May 2024 and may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council (40 MPH Speed Limit) (A419 Ebley Bypass And A419 Bristol Road) (Parishes of Stonehouse And Kings Stanley) (Stroud District) Order 2024".
