

EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF MST 28 (STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, has, by this emergency notice, closed temporarily under the relevant provisions of Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Public Footpath MST28, from its junction with Public Footpath MST27 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 81064/05096 and then extends in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 312 metres to its junction with Public Footpath MST30 at OSGR SO 81208/05350 and shown on the order plan by a bold solid black line, marked A to B.

The said length of the Public Footpath falls within the town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire;

The said closure is necessary for works to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to the definitive line of the said Public Footpath MST28 being unsafe for public use due to dangerous uneven ground conditions.

The public footpath was originally closed for 21 days by notice commencing 5th August 2024. However, as the works to remedy the problem have not been completed it is necessary to extend the closure by notice for a further 21 days commencing 26th August 2024 after which time, if the closure is still required it will be necessary to make an Order.

If made, the Order will authorise the closure of the public footpath for up to six months from the date of the first Notice. However, if the problem continues after this time then it will be necessary to make an application to the Secretary of State for an extension to the closure.

Alternative Routes – via Public Footpaths MST 62 and MST 27, as shown on the order plan

Emergency access, and pedestrian access to adjoining premises, will be maintained.
