

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS EEA 14 & EEA 15 (EASINGTON & GREAT OLDBURY PARISHES) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, <u>intends</u> to make an Order to close temporarily, under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of the Public Footpaths in the Schedule below;

Schedule

Part of Public Footpath EEA 14 in the Parishes of Eastington & Great Oldbury from its junction with Public Footpath EEA 15 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 79307/06854 and then extends in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 324 metres to its junction with EEA 16 at (OSGR) SO 79003/06924 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

Part of Public Footpath EEA 15 in the Parishes of Eastington & Great Oldbury from its junction with Public Footpath EEA 14 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 79307/06854 and then extends in a generally north westerly direction for approximately168 metres to its junction with Public Footpath EEA 16 at (OSGR) SO 779195/06976 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to E.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst construction works are completed.

The said Order will come into force on the **27**th **August 2024**, and it is anticipated that the said footpath will close on that day until **27**th **February 2025**. After this date, if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.

Alternative Route – as indicated on the Order Plan by a dash black line marked A - C - D - E - B.

Pedestrian access to adjoining properties, and emergency access, will be maintained for the duration of the works.
