

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS EEA 14 & EEA 15
(EASTINGTON & GREAT OLDBURY PARISHES) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has further extended the Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of the public footpaths as described in the Schedule below.

Schedule

Part of Public Footpath EEA 14 in the Parishes of Eastington & Great Oldbury from its junction with Public Footpath EEA 15 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 79307/06854 and then extends in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 324 metres to its junction with EEA 16 at (OSGR) SO 79003/06924 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.


Part of Public Footpath EEA 15 in the Parishes of Eastington & Great Oldbury from its junction with Public Footpath EEA 14 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 79307/06854 and then extends in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 168 metres to its junction with Public Footpath EEA 16 at (OSGR) SO 779195/06976 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to E.

The said closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst construction works are completed.

This temporary closure Order came into force on the **27th August 2024** and was expected to end on the **27th February 2025**. However, the works have still not been completed and the Secretary of State has therefore granted an extension until **27th August 2026** or until the works are complete, whichever is earliest.

Alternative Route – as indicated on the Order Plan by a dash black line marked A – C – D – E – B.

Pedestrian access to adjoining properties, and emergency access, will be maintained for the duration of the works.
