

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS MST12 & MST13 (STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has further extended the Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of Public Footpaths MST12 & MST13 as described in the Schedule below;

SCHEDULE

Part of Public Footpath MST 12 from a point at the Sartorius Building extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 50 metres to its junction with Public Footpath MST 13 as indicated on the plan by a solid black line marked A to B.

Part of Public Footpath MST 13 from a point C in extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to a point as indicated on the plan by a solid black line marked C to D.

The said public footpaths fall within Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire;

The said closures are necessary to protect the public due to bridge works being undertaken.


This temporary closure Order came into force on the 27th February 2025 and was expected to end on the 27th August 2025. However, the said works have still not been completed so the Secretary of State has now granted an extension until **27th November 2025** or until the said works are completed, whichever is earliest.
