TEMPORARY CLOSURE PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MST10 (STONEHOUSE TOWN) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2025

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of Public Footpath MST 10 in Stonehouse, from its junction with MST 52, at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 80318/05385 and then extends in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 160 metres to a point at the south western corner of the property 'The Red Lodge' at (OSGR) SO 80390/05496 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

("the Footpath") and the Council is satisfied that use of the Footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of August Two Thousand and Twenty Five and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months or until the said works are completed whichever is earlier;
2. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure Part of Public Footpath MST 10 (Stonehouse Town) (Stroud District) Order 2025";

GENERAL

3. No person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath;
4. The Footpath falls within Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire.
