

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MST 2
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2024

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of Public Footpath MST 2, Stonehouse part of Public Footpath MST 2 from a point at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ST80128/06382 in a generally westerly and northerly direction for approximately 100 metres to a point at OSR ST80154/06416.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of May Two Thousand and Twenty Four and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months
2. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Part Public Footpath MST 2 (Stonehouse Town) Stroud District Order 2024"

GENERAL

3. Except for emergency and pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath
4. The Footpath falls within the town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire
