

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MST 2
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has further extended the Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of Public Footpath MST 2 from a point at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ST80128/06382 in a generally westerly and northerly direction for approximately 100 metres to a point at OSR ST80154/06416 and shown on the attached Map by a solid black line marked A to B.

The Public Footpath falls within the town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District, Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst construction works take place.

The Public Footpath was originally closed by Emergency Notice, commencing 8th April 2024 and extended for a further 21 days before an Order was made. The Order was made on 14th May 2024 effective from the 20th May 2024 and subsequently extended until 20th November 2025. As the works will not complete by then the Secretary of State has further granted an extension until 20th May 2027 or until the works are complete, whichever is earliest.
