

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND RESTRICTION OF 401237 BROWNS LANE AND FOOTWAY
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2026

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of the 401237 Browns Lane and footway, from outside the property known as 'Mayview' to outside the property known as 'Beech Leaves' for a distance of approximately 27 metres ("the Road" and "the Footway") is satisfied that use of the Road and Footway should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall stop, wait or load or cause anyone to stop wait or load along the Road throughout the duration of the said works;
2. Except for pedestrian access to adjoining properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road or the Footway;
3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
5. The Road and Footway fall within Stonehouse Town in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire;
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of February Two Thousand and Twenty Six and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works are completed whichever is the earlier;
7. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure and Restriction of 401237 Browns Lane and Footway (Stonehouse Town) (Stroud District) Order 2026".
8. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or any diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the said works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
