

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
TEMPORARY CLOSURE 401236 CHURCH LANE (STONEHOUSE TOWN)
(STROUD DISTRICT) SPECIAL EVENT ORDER 2026

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for 401236 Church Lane from outside the property known as 'Number 26' to outside the property known as 'Number 10' for a distance of approximately 205 metres is satisfied that traffic along the Road should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event namely the Stonehouse Canal Festival 2026.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed along the Road
2. In this Order –

 "Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the Roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988

 "Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order
3. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a Vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road
4. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a Vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road
5. The Road falls in Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th July 2026 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding three days
7. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure 401236 Church Lane (Stonehouse Town) (Stroud District) Special Event Order 2026"
8. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the event and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.

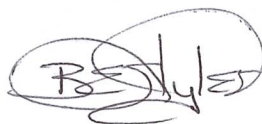
